START

Line between the Committee Boat main mast and Mark No. 5.

FINISH

A line between the Committee Boat main mast and Mark No 6.

SHORTENING COURSE

By flying a White Peter 'S' above Class Code Flag and firing a gun at the end of the round to be completed.

COURSES

All Classes will sail the below course.

Number of rounds will be displayed on the Port side of the Committee Boat between the 5 minute gun and the start of the race.

EACH ROUND OF THE COURSE WILL BE

1(P), 2(P,) 3(P), 4(P) Through the Finish Line.

RESCUE BOATS

Report to Committee Boat by 1200 hours for duties. Rescue craft crews are reminded of the necessity to ferry both before and after racing.

PRIZES

The winning boat in each class will receive a trophy. Any owner whose boat is not registered with Strangford Lough Regatta Conference must submit in writing his name along with Sail Number, class, name of boat and Handicap to the O.O.D. before the start of the race.
