SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

STARTING LINE AND FINISHING LINE

All classes - A line from the rear mast of the committee boat to mark E.



SHORTENING COURSE

By attaching a second buoy marked S to any mark of the course. Yachts should return to the finish from the mark.

TIME LIMIT

Any yacht failing to finish by 17:30 will be deemed to have retired.

COURSE DETAILS

Courses will be displayed on boards on the committee boat. The appropriate course board for each class is specified above.

Note: All boats must pass north of Marks K and R and to the seaward side of marks 2 & 6 unless they are marks of the course.

INSTRUCTIONS TO SAFETY AND RESCUE CREWS

Rescue boats are requested to liaise with the Safety Officer prior to the commencement of racing at 13:45.

Rescue boats are reminded of the necessity to ferry before and after racing.

Crews should be familiar with R.Y.A. and class safety regulations.

PRIZEGIVING AND REFRESHMENTS

All competitors and their families are invited to enjoy refreshments in the clubhouse after racing followed by the award of prizes. A prize will be awarded to the first boat in each race. Visitors are most welcome to join members for the evening entertainment from approximately 8.30pm onwards.
